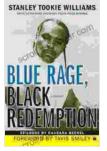

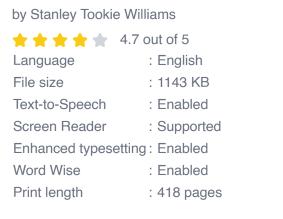

If you are struggling with addiction or mental health issues, I urge you to seek help. There is hope for recovery, and you don't have to do it alone.

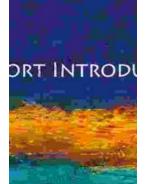
