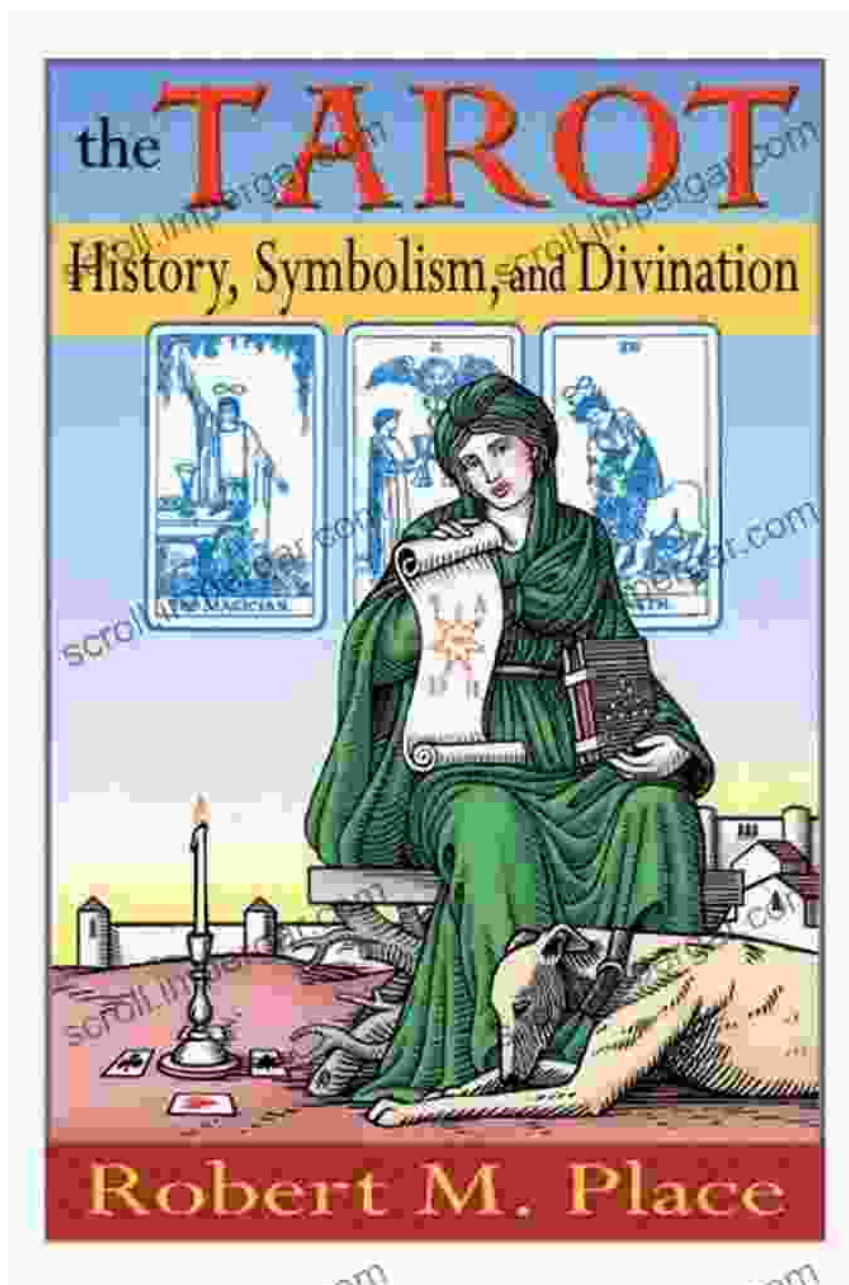

The element of Air is one of the four (or five) elements of modern Western magical systems, the others being earth, fire, water and sometimes spirit. The elements are usually invoked during ritual in order to balance the energy in the sacred space or the practitioner herself, but air may also be invoked independently to lend their energy to spellwork within its sphere of influence or to help the practitioner balance out an excess of earth energy. In tradition that incorporate Christian folklore, Raphael, the cherubim of Air may be called upon.

Air is associated with the respiratory organs and tissues, with breathing, speech, the mind and imagination and with the sense of hearing and smell. It is also associated with the arms, pelvis, calves and bladder and circulatory system.

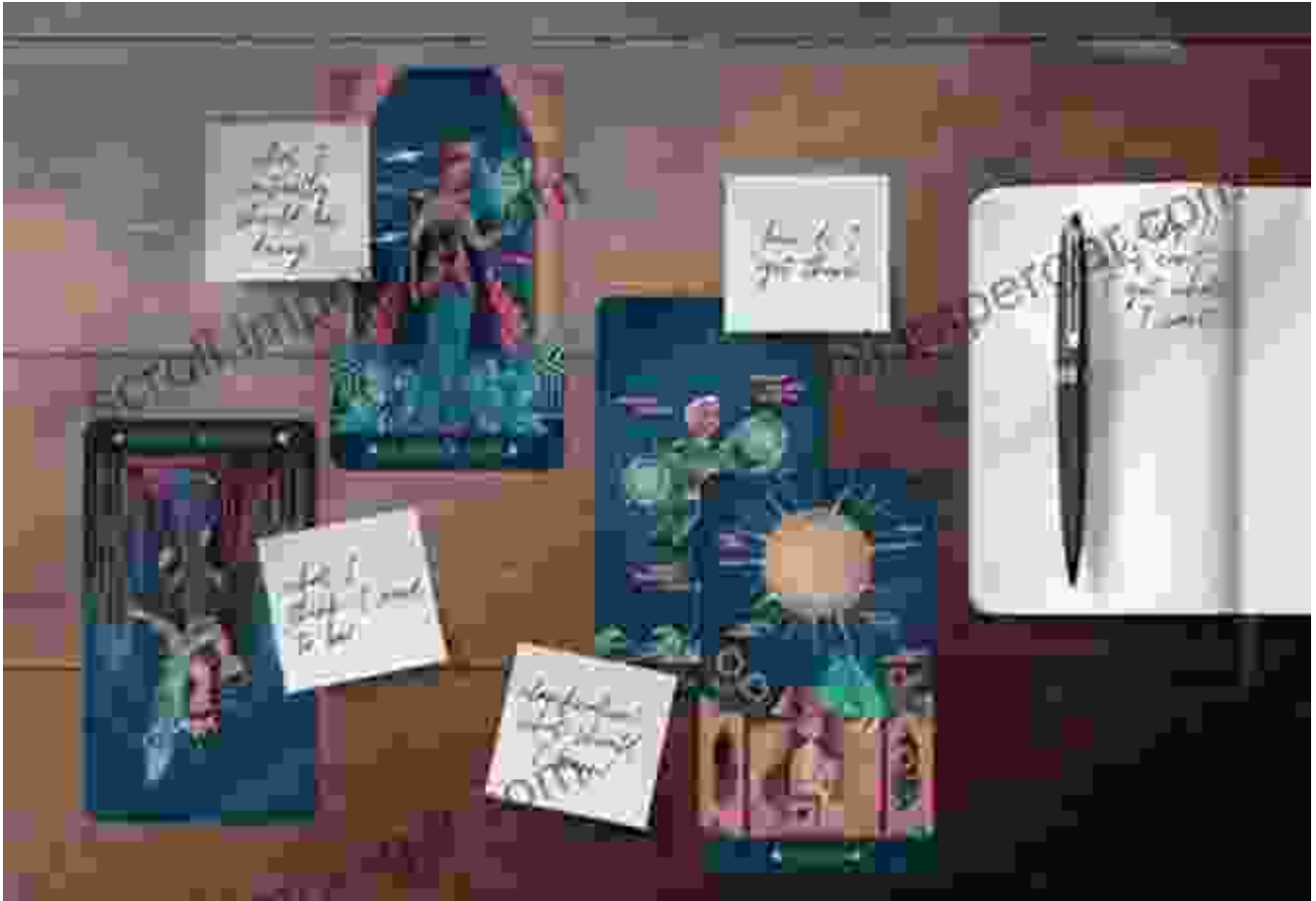

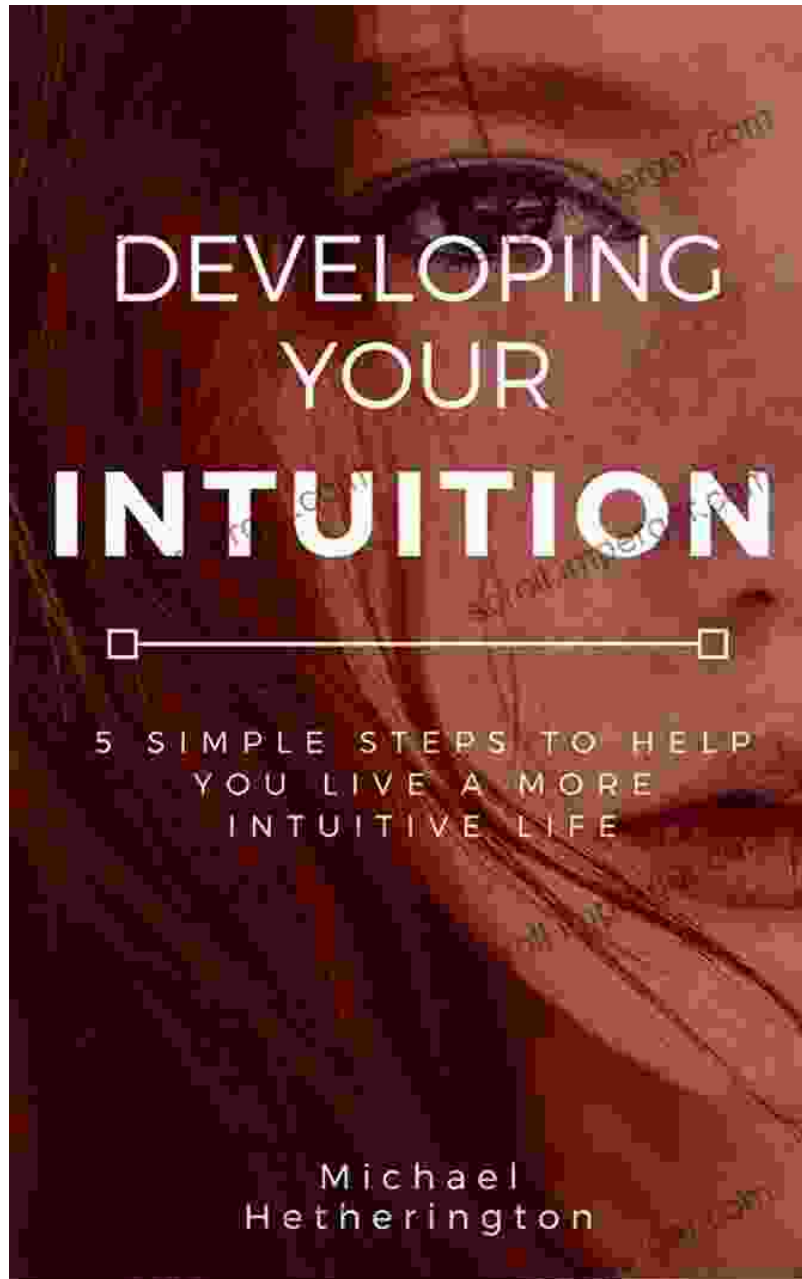

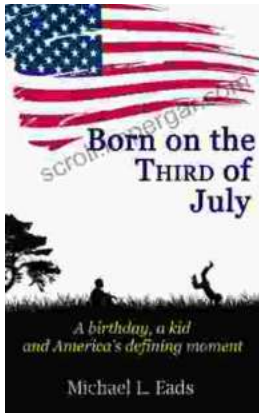
