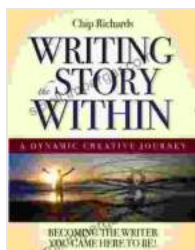

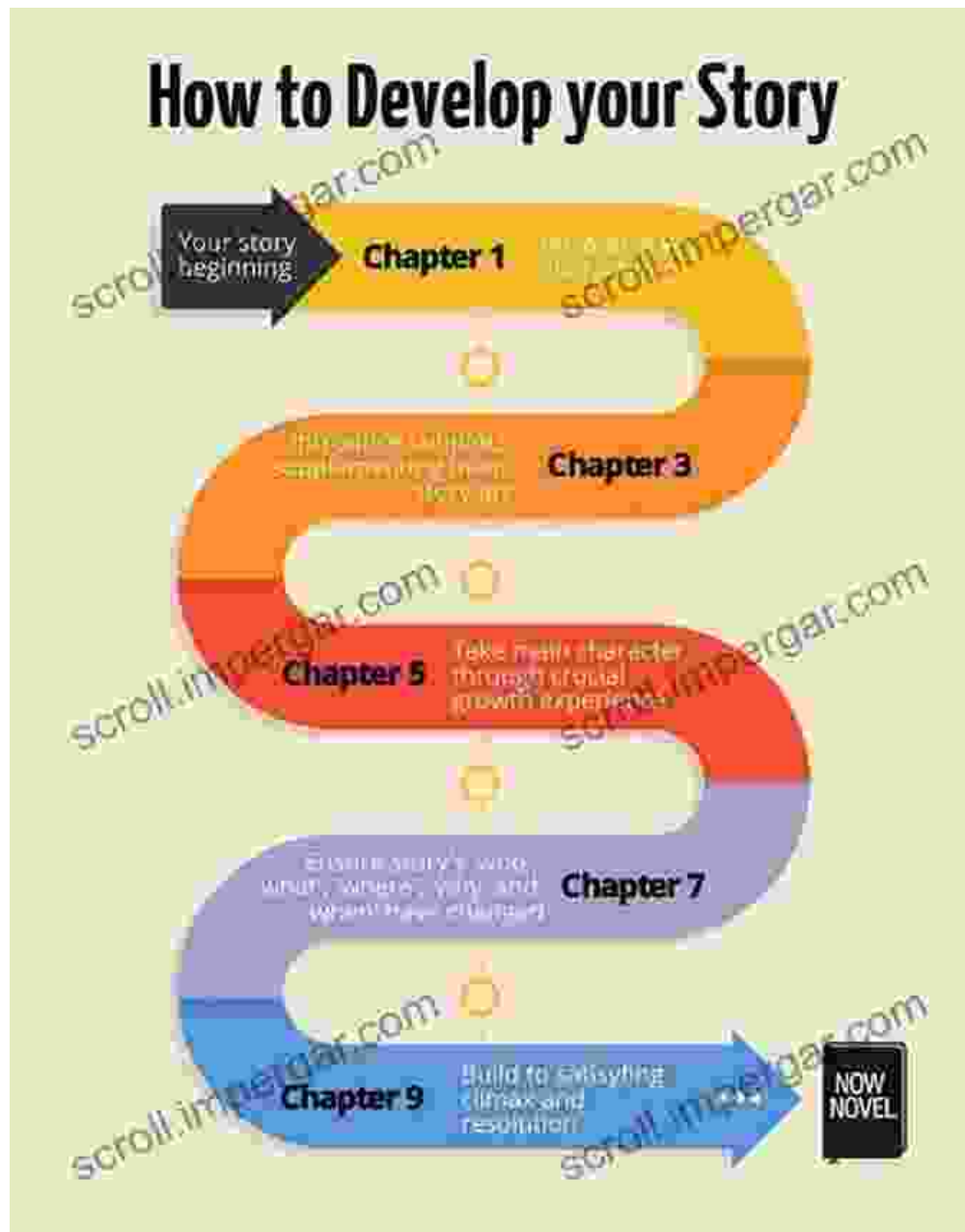

WHAT IS PROSE?

PROSE DEFINITION

- When you read a news in a newspaper or perhaps even a textbook, you are reading prose. The simplest definition of what prose is is a form of writing which has a natural flow with speech and writing. It is grammatically correct but does not have a metrical structure or something like poetry would have, for example.
- However, the prose isn't limited to written works. It is also, for the most part, how we speak in our everyday language and also how we think. When we talk about prose we are referring to a type of language which does not demonstrate any particular structure but leans more in favour of delivering concise and clear language that can be easily understood. The term prose is derived from the Latin language and translates as meaning 'straightforward'.
- When looking at prose you will notice that it is made up of sentences which are grammatically correct and these form paragraphs. In some instances, however, you might come across another type of prose known as prose poetry which blends the

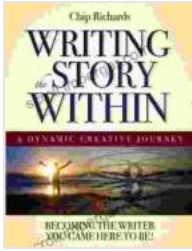

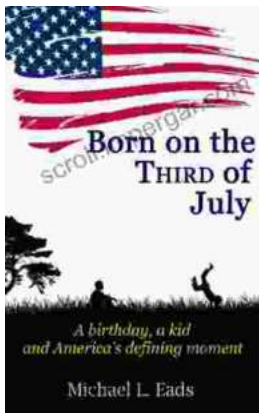
